A cocktail tribute to our boat's first private owner, Kenelm Guinness.

As well as being a director of his family's Guinness brewery in Dublin, Kenelm was a keen racing driver; setting a new land speed record in 1922 - exceeding 133mph in his Sunbeam motor car.

He purchased this surplus minesweeper in 1919, changing her name from 'Samuel Green' to the 'Ocean Rover', transforming it into a gentlemen's pleasure yacht and transporting his racing cars around the world.

SCOTTISH WHISKY REGIONS



HIGHLANDS - The Highlands are Scotland's largest whisky-producing region, offering a wide variety of styles from light and floral to rich and peaty.

SPEYSIDE - Known as the heart of Scotch whisky, Speyside distilleries are famous for their smooth, approachable drams, often aged in sherry casks, delivering a sweeter, fruit-forward profile.

ISLAY - Islay whiskies are renowned for their powerful peat smoke, often with maritime influences. This region is beloved by those who enjoy a strong, smoky character.

LOWLANDS - The Lowland whiskies are known for their light and approachable style, offering an excellent introduction to Scotch whisky with their soft and elegant profiles.

CAMPBELTOWN - Once a bustling whisky hub, Campbeltown is now home to a few distilleries producing robust, slightly salty whiskies that reflect the region's coastal heritage.

ISLANDS - Whisky produced on the wide array of Scottish islands (including Skye, Orkney, and Mull) offer a diverse range of drams, often combining coastal influences with light peat smoke.

BEERS, STOUT & CIDER



Leith's lovely local brewery, Moonwake, is situated 120 metres away (or about 150 steps).

Named after the "Moon's reflection on a body of water", beer experts Vinny and Fin launched their award-winning brewery in 2021 and it has been thriving ever since.

This delicious Red IPA utilises 'Barbe Rouge' hops from France; named after notorious pirate Red Beard.

Expect delicate strawberry, herbal and dried red fruit flavours, with some caramel and toffee.

Eighty Shilling is a deep copper colour, featuring notes of biscuit, toffee and raisin and a hint of spice.
